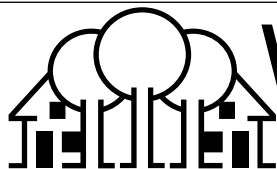

Volunteers wanted!

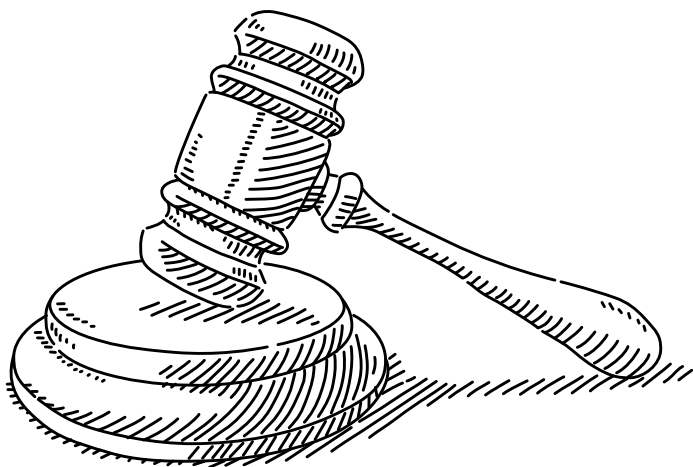

Autumn pumpkins!

Source: Bird protection With pumpkins you cheer up your autumn garden together with (grand) children and help the garden birds.

You can turn a pumpkin into a decorating pumpkin bird, or a beautiful bird feed. Anyway, save the pom-poo seeds you're shoveling out. You can roast them or keep them and sow them in spring.

Make a pumpkin bird

Put a pumpkin bird in the house or garden. Bottle of pumpkins are top, because they already look like a bird. The dried stem is the beak. Plug up your sticky eyes and it's done.



Create bird feed bin

Cut the cap off the pumpkin. Then drain the pumpkin with a spoon, keep the seeds separate. Decorate the side. Put the cap back on the pumpkin in reverse and fill it with flesh and seeds.

Or put it on the ground like food for the marshes, chews. Girls also come for small insects that come to the soft flesh.

Pumpkin seeds as a human snack

You can make pumpkin seeds a nice and healthy snack! Remove the flesh and dry the seeds. Roast them in a little olive oil on a medium heat until they are golden brown and a little crunchy or puffy.

You can also make it a nice soup.



Sow pumpkin seeds

Clean all the seeds. Dry them spread out on kitchen paper and put them in a dry place for at least a week. Then put them in a paper envelope. Don't use a plastic bag, 'cause you'll still have a shot at shim-mel. Store in a dry, dark place.

Pumpkin seeds

In May you can sow the seeds. First, put them on a constantly damp cue paper. If they get carrots after a week, they can get into the ground. Lay them flat, a few inches deep and keep the ground moist. Get a lot of space, the plants are growing!

Pumpkin plant: Happy birds
Birds like to hide under the large leaves of the pumpkin plant. They also find many worms underneath. The large flowers of the pumpkin lure bees, bumblebees, butterflies and other insects. When the flower is pollinated, it grows into a new pumpkin plant and next year you will have new pumpkins.

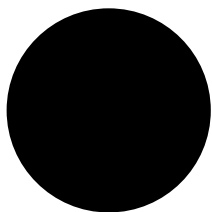

Voluntary Palliative Terminal Care

Often people who are incurably ill want to spend the final phase of their lives at home. Taking care of someone in this situation can be very difficult, even though there is help from home care and the general practitioner. It is good to know that VPTZ volunteers can then provide help and support. The Voluntary Family Care Foundation (VPTZ) is a small organization of well-educated and experienced volunteers who assist patients and their caregivers free of charge. The help provided by the VPTZ is a supplement to the professional care or care provided by family or other caregivers. The wishes of the terminal client and their neighbors are the starting point. For example, it may be a matter of temporarily releasing the relatives, watching, listening and having a conversation. But also to take a walk, read to me, watch tv together or help with simple personal care such as making a cup of tea or a sandwich.

Support is often also important for the carers: part-time or family who sometimes have to be ready 24 hours a day.

Even if the patient is not staying at home but in a hospice, hospital or institution, you can call the VPTZ. The volunteers can be employed both during the day and evening hours. For the night hours there are limited possibilities. In consultation with the patient and the carers it is determined which moments are most appropriate.

You can contact the coordinator of the VPTZ by telephone or email. There will then be a discussion of knowledge in which wishes and possibilities will be examined with you. For the world's top chess, the year 2025 is dedicated to placing the candidate tournament. In the candidate tournament it is decided who will be the challenger of the current world champion (Gukesh Dommaraju). At the beginning of 2026 the tournament will be played and at the end of 2026 the match for the world title is back on the program. The very young World Champion Gukesh (he is only 19) is struggling to live up to his status and there are several potential candidates who can smell their chance as long as Magnus Carlsen is no longer in the title fight. One of these players is the sympathetic grandmaster Anish Giri who is Dutch. The former prodigy (for 31 years and son of a Nepalese mother and a Russian father) has been living in the Netherlands since his 14th and has been in the top 10 of the world almost continuously for over 10 years. He is now married, has a family and knows how to combine this with the global top chess. Nice! Placement for the candidate tournament is not easy and is only possible via some specific routes. A direct placement was possible in the "FIDE Grand Swiss 2025" tournament played in the last month of September. To many surprises Anish Giri won this tournament (he was single 1st!) with a score of 8 points out of 11 games! A fantastic achievement! He gave the whole world's top review, both the upcoming youth from India and the more experienced top players. It was wrong-
